PRACTICAL INFORMATION GUIDE

RENT A CAR

To rent a car in Salobreña ask for information in the Tourist Office. We have agreements with companies that will serve the vehicles in the town.

BANKS

The banks are open from Monday to Friday, from 8:30 to 14:00.

COMPLAINTS AND CLAIMS

We have complaint forms available for customers. They can be requested at our service. The Salobreña Town Hall has a Consumer Information Service available to the client which deals with complaints about tourist and commercial services.

CURRENCY

The currency in Spain is the Euro. Check the exchange rate at your bank. We recommend travellers visiting Spain to use a credit card for payments in our territory, as the market exchange rate is generally applied. See in detail the specifications and commissions of the issuer of your credit card.

Currency is not exchanged in Salobreña. To exchange currency in banks your must have a bank account in Spain. We recommend that you exchange currency in your

origin, or at the airport of destination.

CLIENTS WITH REDUCED MOBILITY

Most hotel and accommodation establishments are accessible to wheelchair users. Salobreña Castle has adapted its visit to make it wheelchair accessible. Ask at the Tourist Office for the accessible itinerary to reach the monument which is located in the upper part of the village. All public services, including the Tourist Information Service, are accessible. There are taxis in the municipality with a wheelchair ramp service. If you need to hire a wheelchair, consult orthopaedic aids store Salobreña.

ELECTRICITY

The electrical appliances (Alternating Current) in Spain work at 220 volts, distribution frequency 60 Hz. The plugs follow the European system formed by two elements, round plugs with two holes.

EMERGENCIES

The emergency health number in Spain is 112.

INTERNET

A network of cafés and taverns with free WIFI offer Internet services in the town and the promenade. Our beaches also have Internet access through the Wifi-beach network. Ask the beach restaurant how to get access. If you need Internet access in the village of Salobreña you can freely access the WIFI points available. Wifi Free: Plaza Juan Carlos I. MOBILE PHONE

To top up credit on your mobile phone you can do it at the supermarket checkouts. It is required to provide the linked telephone number. The telephone shops will tell you the best rates.

their weight)

Two-way roads or roads with passing lanes: 100km/h (80 for caravans and

trailer vehicles)

Other roads, local, county: 90km/h (70 for caravans and vehicles with trailers)

• Traffic in towns and villages: 50km/h
